

THE COMMITTEE TO PRESERVE THE UPPER WEST SIDE

Testimony of LANDMARK WEST! Certificate of Appropriateness Committee Before the Landmarks Preservation Commission 330 West End Avenue September 28, 2021

LANDMARK WEST! is a not-for-profit community organization committed to the preservation of the architectural heritage of the Upper West Side.

The Certificate of Appropriateness Committee wishes to comment on 330 West End Avenue, an Arts & Crafts style apartment building from within the West End-Collegiate Historic District Extension. This landmark was designed by Robert M. Farrington and built 1915-1916. The application is to replace greenhouse structures on balconies.

The Landmark West Certificate of Appropriateness Committee recognizes these greenhouses are non-historic but grandfathered elements. We believe the new anodized bronze color will be more appropriate and the other improvements more efficient. Our Committee did wonder why the third floor was not receiving the same design and requests the applicant consider the new design materials, color and form as the standard for a greenhouse masterplan for this landmark.
