LANDMARK WEST! is a not-for-profit community organization committed to the preservation of the architectural heritage of the Upper West Side.

The Certificate of Appropriateness Committee wishes to comment on 60 West 91st Street, a Romanesque Revival style rowhouse designed by Henry L. Harris and built in 1889-90 from within the Upper West Side/Central Park West Historic District. The application is to construct a rear addition.

The LANDMARK WEST! Certificate of Appropriateness Committee believes this is a fairly inoffensive addition to an already approved at staff level 3-story rear yard addition and we recommend approval.

The LANDMARK WEST Certificate of Appropriateness Committee consistently laments the incremental shift in the character of the donut, and cautions the cumulative effect more incursions into the donut will create.
